

Sizzling Summer at PSEP!

Kept our 45 kids Learning- ages 3 to 13.

- This year, for the first time, we enrolled pre-K students. In addition to the core elementary cohort, 13 pre-K children participated actively over the summer. They utilized Khan Academy Kids and other interactive learning tools to build critical math readiness, early literacy, motor control, and emotional development skills for a smooth, confident transition into public school.
- 29 students in grades K to 7 used IXL to maintain and raise academic levels. **Here are the results:**

Reading, language arts

- 28 of 29 elementary students successfully maintained or raised their reading levels! 16 Raised Levels, 12 Maintained Levels

Mathematics Skills Retention

- 26 of 28 elementary students successfully maintained or raised their math skill levels! 13 Raised Levels, 13 Maintained Levels
